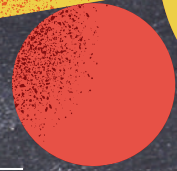


TATVA JAIN - STD 10

Biography on Mr Bean

Mr Rowan Atkinson was born on 6th January, 1955 to Eric Atkinson and Ella May in the county Durham, England. He was married to Sunita Sastry and has two children Benjamin and Lily. He has also voiced his support for the 'Reform Section 5' campaign.
